- Night at the hotel

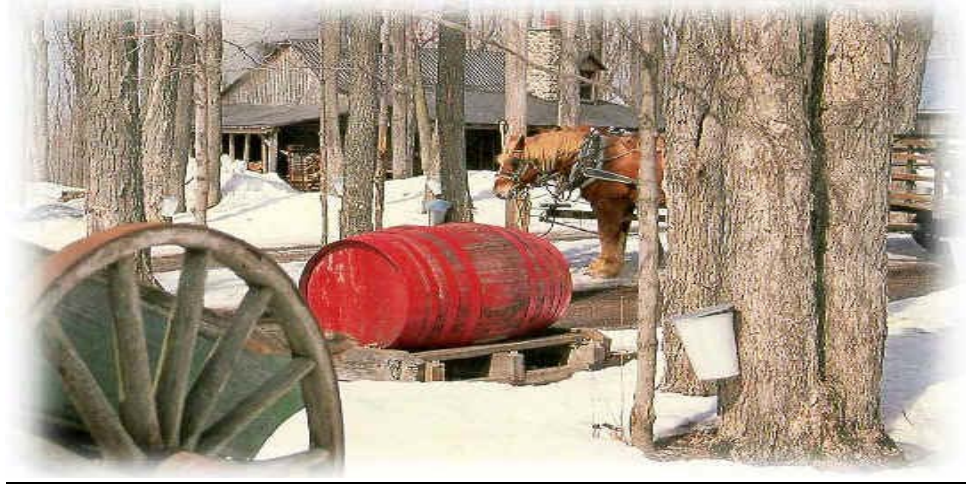
DAY 2: MONTREAL

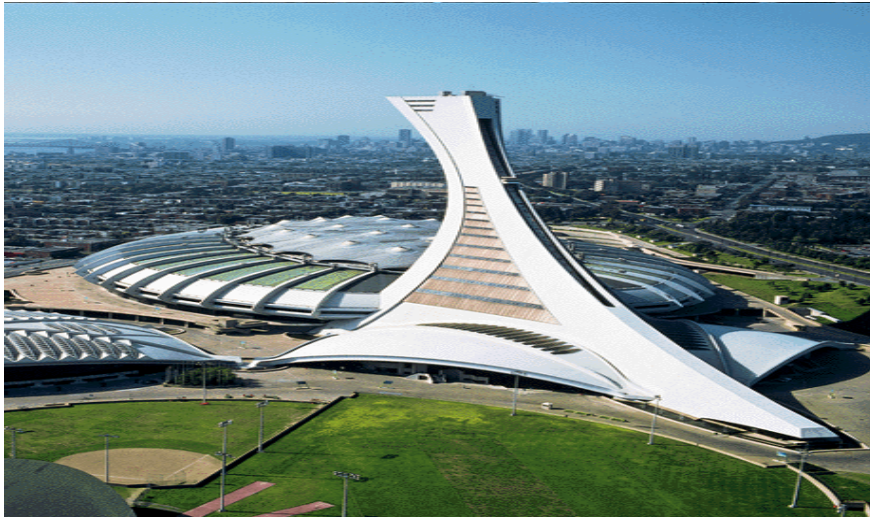


DAY 3: MONTREAL

- **Breakfast** at the hotel
- Visit of the **Montreal Symphonic Orchestra**. A new way of getting to know the Montreal Symphonic Orchestra, designed especially for students. Enjoy the interaction among conductor, soloists and 100 musicians. A session lasting two and a half hours enables the audience to observe each of the orchestral sections at their leisure and hear works performed in their entirety. Here you will also discover, plants and animals living in faithful reproductions of their natural habitats.
- Visit of the **Montreal Insectarium**. This museum, the only one of its kind in North America. Insects! Fascinating, fearsome mysterious insects. This is the perfect place to learn more about their unknown universe. Admire insects of surprising beauty, colours, agility and astounding adaptability.

- Visit of the **Montreal Planetarium**. The Planetarium presents shows to introduce young and old alike to the marvels of the universe, beneath the enormous hemispheric dome of Star Theatre.
