

STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Dear Students and Parents:

Here is an outline of the standards of conducts expected of students during our travel abroad:

- 1) Proper behavior is expected at all times. Remember, you are representing your country. Show respect for language and customs different than your own.
- 2) Hotel check-in/out sheets will be posted in each hotel lobby. Inform us of your whereabouts during the times when students are free to choose their own activities.
- 3) Never go out alone. Always be with at least two other participants to avoid getting lost or any other unpleasant experiences.
- 4) No smoking, drinking or using drugs during the trip.
- 5) Curfews will be established with your group leader. There will be nightly room checks to ensure that everyone is back safely.
- 6) Be on time. Late starts can be annoying to the whole group, not to mention to your bus driver and guide.

Any student whose attitude or behavior is detrimental to the smooth functioning of the group, who consistently acts independently of teacher admonishments and warnings, may be sent back home before the end of the tour at the parents' expense.

All efforts will be made to solve the conflict, including a phone call, prior to sending a student home.
